



Why did you need Ground Penetrating Radar?

The GPR service was required for a site development on a Meijer outlot. The Meijer Company knew that there were Meijer Co. underground utilities on the site, but did not know where, exactly. The outlot was at one of the original Meijer stores, built about 1980, so there were no accurate plans available. The Meijer manager required the location of these utilities on the construction plans as a condition prior to approving the site development plans.

What did we locate for you?
